- A non-residency high school program for pregnant and parenting youth with children up to 2 years, affiliated with the Winnipeg Adult Education Center and provides an academic focused program. Students work on 30 credit programs or Mature Student programs.
- Family Studies and Food & Nutrition courses are mandatory. Available student supports are a Teen Health Clinic, Public Health Nurse, Social Worker, Healthy Baby- Healthy Start for Mom and Me program, pre-natal classes, Building Student Support with Indigenous Parents (BSSIP) and Career Trek. Bus tickets to qualifying students, breakfast, lunch and child care.
- Breastfeeding supports are available.
